

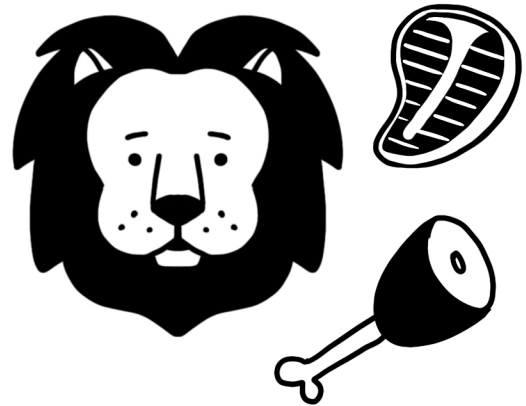
HERBIVORE

An animal that eats plants. In the food chain, herbivores are primary consumers. Herbivores can be all sizes, from tiny insects to huge elephants. Most herbivores are called prey.



CARNIVORE

An animal that eats meat. In the food chain, carnivores can be secondary and tertiary consumers. Most carnivores are called predators.



OMNIVORE

An animal that eats both plants and meat. Omnivores can be secondary and tertiary consumers in a food chain.
